What you need to complete a FAFSA:

- FSA ID
- Social Security Number
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. Citizen)
- Your 2018 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- Bank statements and records of investments
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable)
- An email account

In most cases, you will need the above info for both you and your parents
